Greendale constructed a new hi-tech two storey sixth form building providing 570m² of ground floor space and 370m² first floor accommodation that also included an open gallery over the refectory and hall.

A large, clear span roof structure was created incorporating laminated timber beams and tensioned steel components. In addition, we converted the flat roof over the existing sports hall to a pitched structure to make an architecturally seamless building.
